Cooking

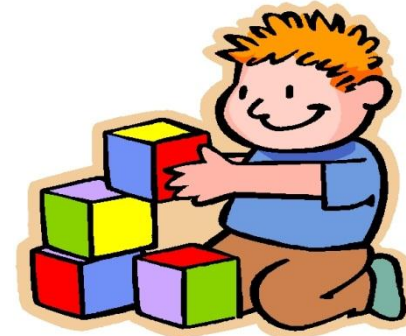
Take turns to stir the mixture.
